Steps for seeking reimbursement:

Email Melissa Tumblin at EarCommunity@gmail.com and explain that you have a patient in need of help in regards to a fitting/programming. If you have had the CPT code 92700 denied for the fitting/programming service, please tell Melissa this or the reason why you are reaching out for reimbursement. Please share what the fitting/programming fee will cost for you to help this patient.

Patients must have microtia and/or aural atresia with BAHS needing to be fitted/programmed. (1) reimbursement per patient only. Patients must be in the US/US appointments only.

Ear Community will let you know right away if you can request reimbursement for the fitting/programming fee or if all funds have been exhausted for the year.

You may need to have Ear Community set up in your system as a vendor in order to generate a billing invoice. This invoice with the fitting/programming fee should be sent to Ear Community for reimbursement (e-mailed or mailed). This can be the insurance denial for the fitting/programming or simply the financial agreement form between the audiologist and the patient agreeing to the amount to be paid out of pocket. Ear Community will issue reimbursement via check payment to the attention of the audiology clinic/audiologist's name with date of service and patient's name noted.

It is Ear Community's goal to help as many children and adults to hear their best as much as possible. The reimbursement for audiologists for the patient fitting/programming will be on a first come first serve basis. **Pax's Ear Fund is made possible by a sweet little boy named Pax who was born with microtia and atresia.
